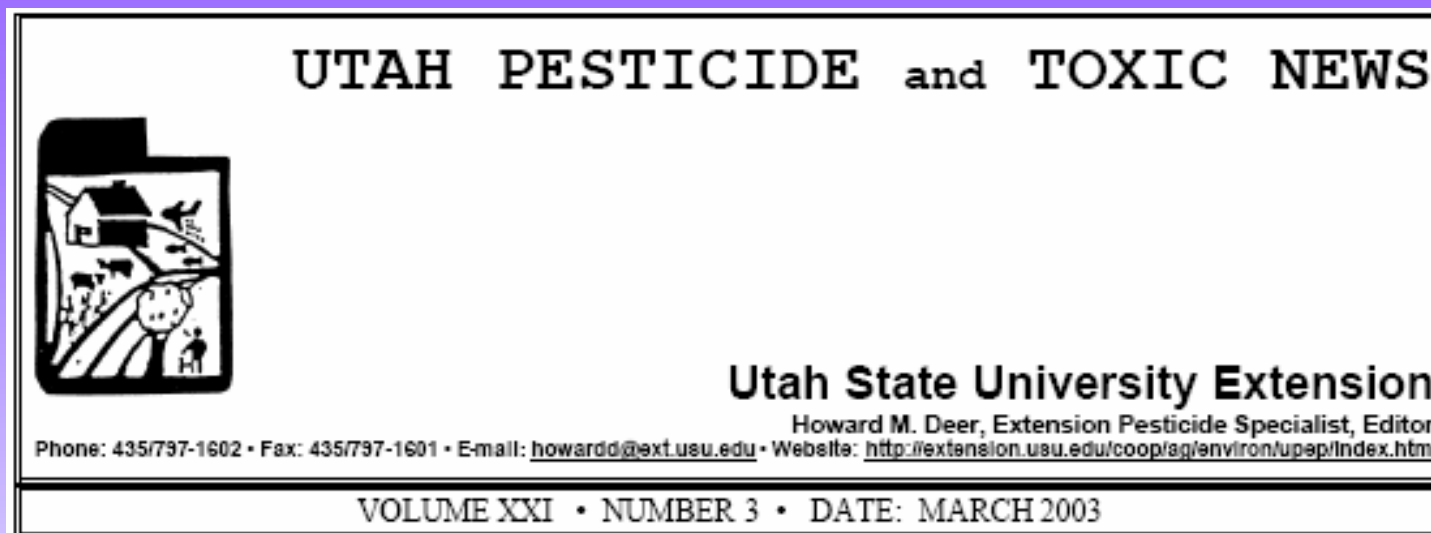

Tests Confirm Toxic Timber In Playground

Your third area of discussion addresses the use of CCA-treated wood in playground equipment. The federal Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) recently received a petition to ban the use of CCA wood in playground equipment (66 FR 36756) and is working with U.S. EPA to develop sampling protocols in response to this petition (66 FR 48428). The CPSC website at www.cpsc.gov provides additional information regarding CPSC's work in this area.

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CCA-TREATED WOOD VOLUNTARILY CANCELLED FOR RESIDENTIAL USES

On March 17, EPA granted the voluntary cancellation and use termination requests affecting virtually all residential uses of chromated copper arsenate (CCA) treated wood. Under this action, affected CCA products
